Due to Social Distancing all Donors must register on-line in advance. Log onto www.cbblifeblood.org Click on events and select January 18 - Pipestone County Medical Center and choose your time & submit. For more information call 877-877-3070 or call 507- 825-6166 All Donors must wear a mask. Do not donate if in the past 14 days you had symptoms of COVID 19 such as: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, runny nose, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell. Do not donate if in the past 14 days you had a positive diagnostic test (nasal swab test) for COVID-19 but you never developed symptoms. Do not donate if you currently have a pending COVID -19 test because you had symptoms from the above list, or if you have been asked to quarantine by state, school or health official. There is a 2 week deferral after anyone has received the COVID vaccination. **There is a critical shortage of Blood due to COVID-19 pandemic and your donation can help save a life.**
