<u>Meals on Wheels needs volunteers</u>. Meals on Wheels is in desperate need of revitalizing our volunteer list to help to deliver meals-on-wheels within the community of Pipestone. We currently have approximately 40 individuals in the community that utilize our services of receiving a daily hot meal. We are seeking support within the community to help to get these meals out daily, Monday through Friday. Meals are delivered starting at 10:00 am and usually take just 30-45 minutes each day. We provide all of the direction for how to complete this with volunteers. Volunteer mileage reimbursement is also available to those that would like to receive a partial reimbursement for use of their vehicle and gas costs. Volunteers can commit as they are able: by day(s), or a week at a time, we welcome all volunteer capacities. Our volunteer pool has dramatically dwindled since COVID, and we need community member support to help to ensure these meals can go out. ## Genesis 22: 7 - 14 ESV

<sup>7</sup> And Isaac said to his father Abraham, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." He said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?" <sup>8</sup> Abraham said, "God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." So they went both of them together.

<sup>9</sup> When they came to the place of which God had told him, Abraham built the altar there and laid the wood in order and bound Isaac his son and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood. <sup>10</sup> Then Abraham reached out his hand and took the knife to slaughter his son. <sup>11</sup> But the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, "Abraham, Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." <sup>12</sup> He said, "Do not lay your hand on the boy or do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son, from me." <sup>13</sup> And Abraham lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him was a ram, caught in a thicket by his horns. And Abraham went and took the ram and offered it up as a burnt offering instead of his son. <sup>14</sup> So Abraham called the name of that place, "The LORD will provide"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of the LORD it shall be provided."
