### **Community Events**

**Meals on Wheels needs volunteers.** Meals on Wheels is in desperate need of revitalizing our volunteer list to help to deliver meals-on-wheels within the community of Pipestone. We currently have approximately 40 individuals in the community that utilize our services of receiving a daily hot meal. We are seeking support within the community to help to get these meals out daily, Monday through Friday. Meals are delivered starting at 10:00 am and usually take just 30-45 minutes each day. We provide all of the direction for how to complete this with volunteers. Volunteer mileage reimbursement is also available to those that would like to receive a partial reimbursement for use of their vehicle and gas costs. Volunteers can commit as they are able: by day(s), or a week at a time, we welcome all volunteer capacities. Our volunteer pool has dramatically dwindled since COVID, and we need community member support to help to ensure these meals can go out. ## Genesis 22: 7 - 14 ESV

<sup>7</sup> And Isaac said to his father Abraham, “My father!” And he said, “Here I am, my son.” He said, “Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?” <sup>8</sup> Abraham said, “God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son.” So they went both of them together.
