REMEMBER: If PAS school is cancelled due to weather so are all Youth activities.

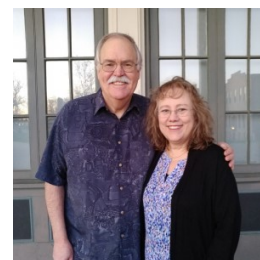
