Luther's explanation of the 3rd Article from the Large Catechism

'I believe in the Holy Christian Church"

What does this mean?

"I believe that there is upon earth
a little holy group and congregation of pure saints,
under one Head, even Christ.

This group is called together by the Holy Spirit in one faith, one mind, and understanding; with many different gifts, yet agreeing in love, without sects or schisms.

I am also a part and member of this same group, a sharer and joint owner of all the goods it possesses.

> I am brought to it and incorporated into it by the Holy Spirit through having heard and continuing to hear God's Word, which is the beginning of entering it.

In the past, before we had attained to this, we were altogether of the devil, knowing nothing about God and about Christ.
