Extreme hunger can be especially dangerous for children under 5—leading to stunted growth, infection, and



death. Samaritan’s Purse seeks out little ones who are at risk, giving them nutrient-dense food that will help their bodies develop. We also monitor their growth, and offer therapeutic care for those who are already malnourished. For \$9, you can provide a week of food for a child, and show them that “we love because He first loved us” (1 John 4:19, ESV).

***Luther's explanation of the 3rd Article from the Large Catechism***

'I believe in the Holy Christian Church''

**What does this mean?**

“I believe that there is upon earth  
a little holy group and congregation of pure saints,  
under one Head, even Christ.

This group is called together by the Holy Spirit  
in one faith, one mind, and understanding;  
with many different gifts, yet agreeing in love,  
without sects or schisms.

I am also a part and member of this same group,  
a sharer and joint owner of all the goods it possesses.

I am brought to it and incorporated into it  
by the Holy Spirit through having heard  
and continuing to hear God's Word,  
which is the beginning of entering it.

In the past, before we had attained to this,  
we were altogether of the devil,  
knowing nothing about God and about Christ.

So, until the Last Day,  
the Holy Spirit abides with the holy congregation or Christendom.

Through this congregation He brings us to Christ  
and He teaches and preaches to us the Word.

By the Word He works and promotes sanctification,  
causing this congregation daily to grow  
and to become strong in the faith and its fruit, which He produces.”
