<u>Ukraine Relief Opportunity:</u> Tomasz Chmiel attended our Free Lutheran Seminary and continues to remain active on the AFLC Clergy Roster. He and his family live in Lviv, Ukraine. They are included in the rotation of our monthly missionaries. Their sending organization (Josiah Venture) has a special fund set up specifically for the crisis in Ukraine - https://www.josiahventure.com/give/projects/ukraine. Churches can specify their giving to either getting refugees out or sending aid in. Tomasz has already taken trips into Ukraine to deliver humanitarian aid and bring back refugees.

Mikal Klus (resident of Trinec, Czech Republic) also attended the Free Lutheran Seminary and maintains ties with the AFLC. He is working to help the Ukrainian people as well.

A group of Christian business people in Sioux Falls, SD (Kingdom Capital Fund) have set aside \$140,000 in matching funds for those who wish to give toward the Ukraine Crisis. These funds would be carefully distributed in a managed way to several different church groups and ministry partner connections (which would include the work of Mikal Klus and Tomasz Chmiel).
