Results from test This is Denis Parsley with the results of a question posed at the beginning of adult Sunday school last week. If there are 60 people in a group, such as in a bar, in a church, at a game, what are the odds that 2 of them will have the same birth date (not same year). I handed out small pieces of paper, about 40 total and told people they could put their names on or not. Not really important unless you want to win the prize. About 20 were turned in. The guess submitted were as follows. 100% - 1. 94.4% - 2. 25% - 1. 20% - 1. 16% - 1. 15% - 1. 10% - 1. 9% - 1. 8% - 1. 6% - 2. 5% - 1. 4.5% - 1. 2% - 3. 1% - 1. .05% - 1. .01% - 1. The correct answer according to the probability calculation index is 99.4%. They did this survey to the students at the University of California Technical were students are only admitted if they are very strong in math. They did not have time to google it, just think about it. Their guesses were mostly 10% - 50%. **The point is** that when we hear something that seems right or that someone tells us is right, it could be a long way off. I think the line of, “**trust, but verify**” makes sense. Speaking about being a long way off, I thought 16% would be right. It amazes me to see how FAR from correct we can be.
