Here is what CTK can do to prevent the spread of the covid-19 virus.

From The Banquet's webpage: The Banquet has taken the Covid 19 health alert very seriously and following CDC recommendations has changed how we serve our guests. We now serve meals at the door in to go containers and will do so until the pandemic warnings have been cleared. This requires fewer people to serve the meal; however, many groups have canceled so we are relying upon our Banquet Angels and other community members to prep and serve our 16 meals a week. Each meal requires 6 people to prepare the meal and 6-8 to serve. We have also taken steps to further clean and sanitize our buildings and are diligent in wearing gloves and practicing social distancing. People who are experiencing symptoms or Covid-19 are asked not to volunteer at this time.
