Here is what CTK can do to prevent the spread of the covid-19 virus.

From The Banquet's webpage: The Banquet has taken the Covid 19 health alert very seriously and following CDC recommendations has changed how we serve our guests. This requires fewer people to serve the meal; however, many groups have canceled so we are relying upon our Banquet Angels and other community members to prep and serve our 16 meals a week. Each meal requires 6 people to prepare the meal and 6-8 to serve. We have also taken steps to further clean and sanitize our buildings and are diligent in wearing gloves and practicing social distancing.
