Community Events

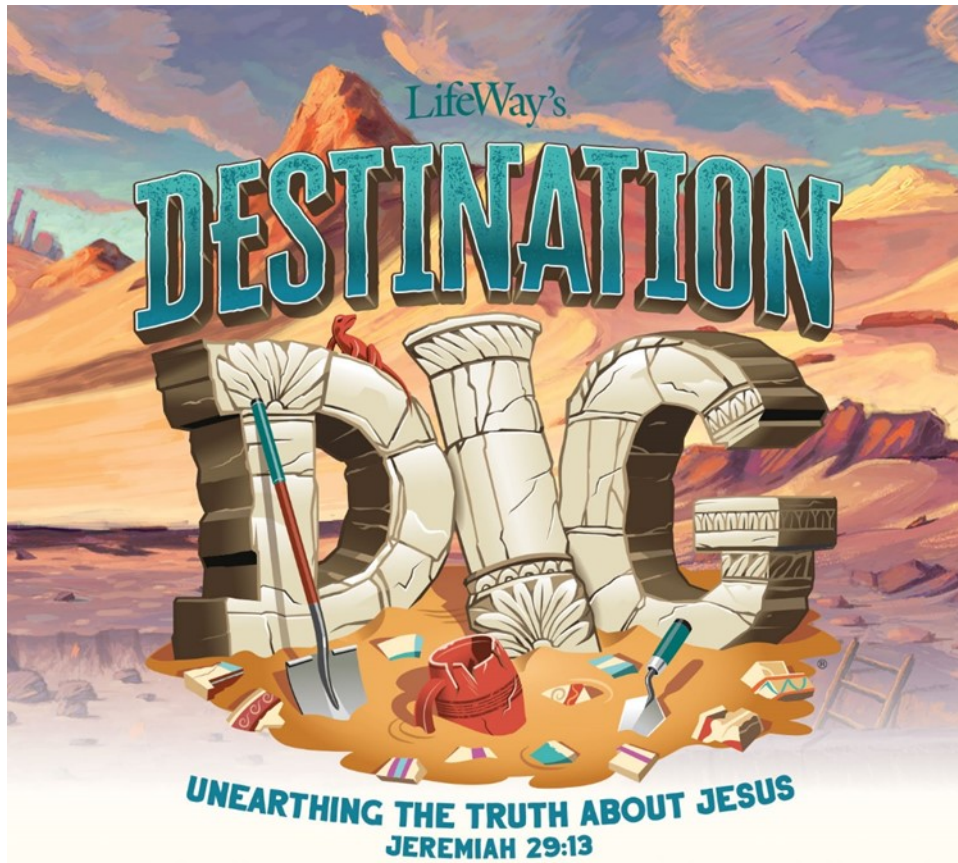
