Here is what CTK can do to prevent the spread of the covid-19 virus.

If this changes, I will let you know asap. We provide gloves & masks and ask our volunteers and staff to wear them. Obviously, we don’t want anyone with a compromised health system to serve and endanger themselves.

I know these are unusual times and you have to do what you believe is right for your group. We do understand. We are now serving 16 meals a week at our new Banquet West facility is open at 5th and Marion. I know our guests miss the dining room experience.
