Luther's Small Catechism: Explanation of Commandments 5-8

Confession of Faith (Pastor will read the question and the congregation will respond with the bold print)

Thou shalt not kill.

Q.—What does this mean?

A.—We should fear and love God so that we do our neighbor no bodily harm nor case him any suffering, but help and befriend him in every need.

Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Q.—What does this mean?

A.—We should fear and love God so that we live a chaste and pure life in word and deed, and that husband and wife love and honor each other.

Thou shalt not steal.

Q.—What does this mean?

A.—We should fear and love God so that we do not rob our neighbor of his money or property, nor bring them into our possession by unfair dealing or fraud, but help him to improve and protect his property and living.

Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Q.—What does this mean?

A.—We should fear and love God so that we do not deceitfully lie about, betray, backbite, nor slander our neighbor, but defend him, speak well of him, and put the most charitable construction on all that he does.
