Dear Congregation, As you know Gov Walz signed Executive Order 20-81 which requires Minnesotans to wear a face covering in indoor businesses and indoor public settings. We know that a fair percentage of people who have the virus do not show symptoms, yet they can pass the virus on to others. Social distancing is one of the best ways to avoid COVID-19 and CTK encourages social distancing between families as we gather for meetings and services. However, studies do show that masks can protect people from you should you be carrying the virus as they can help reduce the amount of droplets released into the air around you. For that reason, masks can help slow the spread of the virus and CTK will have masks available if you need one. Meaning of the Second Article of the Apostles' Creed

What does this mean? I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true Man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, bought me and freed me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with silver or gold, but with His holy and precious blood and with His innocent sufferings and death; in order that I might be His own, live under Him in His kingdom, and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, even as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.
