<u>Dear Congregation</u>, As you know Gov Walz signed Executive Order 20-81 which requires Minnesotans to wear a face covering in indoor businesses and indoor public settings. NOTE: The location for donors to register will again be the Stucco house located at 822 4th Ave SW. Donors will enter the house to register and will walk to the Community Blood Bank Bloodmobile that is parked in front of the house for the collection. There will be 2 busses.

Appointments are the key to ensuring social distancing for the blood drives. All donors are encouraged to log onto website at www.cbblifeblood.org to schedule your appointment and select "events" then click on August 19th, "Pipestone Heroes" or call 507-825-6166 Community Blood Bank Staff members are screened daily and wear face masks at all times. Donors must be 17 years old (16 with parental consent found on website www.cbblifeblood.org). Please bring your Driver's license. Remember to bring a valid ID, eat a good meal and drink plenty of water before donation and avoid energy drinks before donating. Do not donate if you have had a fever, cough, shortness of breath, runny nose, sore throat, vomiting/diarrhea in the past 14 days. Do not donate if you have cared for, lived with, or otherwise had close contact with individuals diagnosed with or suspected of having COVID 19 or if you have been diagnosed with or suspected of having COVID 19 in the past 14 days including having a pending COVID 19 test because of any of the above symptoms.
