Youth and Family Ministry Scheduling Notes from Pastor Joe:

Sunday Evening Studies: We're aiming to have our family + youth studies meet on Sunday evenings. These studies are focused on the youth and their families, but other families are welcome to come if you are plugged in to our weekly family devotional, which will serve as the basis for our lesson. These devotionals will be distributed to youth families (and others interested) to help facilitate family devotions the week before and prepare hearts for the Sunday evening studies. **The proposed schedule for the Sunday night studies will look something like this:**

4:30 pm - Meet at the church to carpool to host home

5 to 5:45 - Eat and enjoy fellowship

5:45 to 6:15 - Lesson time

6:15 - Gradually depart back to church for follow-up activities (more visiting, community youth group, etc.)

Youth Sunday School: After some feedback from youth families, we are planning on having a youth-age Sunday School class that will meet at the regular Sunday School time. Honeybees Noah's ark accommodated "every beast after its kind (Genesis 7:14), which presumably included buzzing bees! Honeybees turned out to be a special blessing for the Yazidis—a people group in northern Iraq, who believe the ark landed on their Mount Sinjar. Indeed, bees in these hills produce some of the world's finest honey. Samaritan's Purse has provided more than a thousand beehives to Yazidi families in Jesus' Name, and we also have similar projects in Africa. Some have used income to put roofs on their houses, pay school fees, and build a village church. **For just \$20 per family, we can provide a hive, equipment, and training.**
