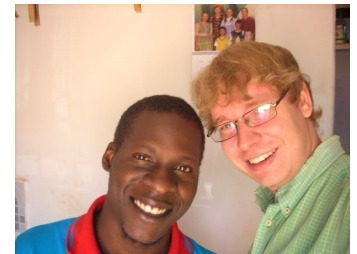
Community Events

Meaning of the Third Article of the Apostles' Creed

He daily forgives abundantly all my sins and the sins of all believers, and at the last day will raise up me and all the dead and will grant everlasting life to me and to all who believe in Christ.
