Connection sheets showing our students and their current ties are in his office ready to be filled in with about 4 adults per student (yes, even confirmation students will have more ties than just their prayer partners). This will take involvement on a congregation-wide level, so thank you for your willingness so far to tie together this congregation, its families, and its youth!
