Second Sunday of Advent

Read the following.

Today is the second Sunday in Advent. Last week we lit the **Prophets' Candle**. This week we will light the **Angels' Candle**. The angel said to Joseph in Matthew 1:20-23 ²⁰ But after he had considered these things, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, don't be afraid to take Mary as your wife, because what has been conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹ She will give birth to a son, and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." ²² Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: ²³ See, the virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son,

²³ See, the virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they will name him Immanuel, which is translated "God is with us."

The angels also said to the shepherds in Luke 2:10-11,

¹⁰"Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people;

¹¹for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.

(The Prophets' Candle and the Angels' Candle are lit while the Scripture is Read – the pink candle labeled #1 and the purple candle labeled #2)
