# 3 rd Sunday of Advent.

Reader 1: The past two Sundays, we lit the candles of hope and peace. Today we light the Joy Candle

Luke 2:10-11 say, "And the angel said to them,

'Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." (ESV)

Reader 2: The shepherds heard the angel's proclamation, and were filled with both awe and joy. They were mere shepherds, considered by some as the lowest of the low.

But the angel comes to them. Filled with joy they go

Straight to the stable and kneel before the Christ Child.

What joy fills the heart of all who grasp that Jesus loves us and forgives all our sins and failings so that He can actually live in us through His Spirit?

Prayer: Father, thank you for the joy the angels had in delivering their message to the shepherds. Thank you for the joy of Jesus' birth, and the joy of the new birth we can all experience through Jesus. In Jesus' name, we pray.

Student: Lord, forgive us for misusing the money and time that you provide.

All: Teach us instead to work diligently and be generous with our stuff. (7)

## **Confession of Faith**

Student: Let's Confess God's Truth about Creation

All: I believe God is eternal, with no beginning, and is present everywhere. I believe He created the heavens and the earth. He pronounced all things to be good.

Student: Let's Confess God's Truth about the Fall

All: I believe Adam and Eve were deceived by the devil and disobeyed their creator,

And because of this, we too, are separated from God. I believe that God promised to make a
way for us all to be restored to Him.

Student: Let's Confess God's Truth about the 10 Commandments

The consequences of our inability to keep the commandments is eternal death under God's just wrath.
