The Angels' Candle

John 8:12: "Jesus said, I am the light of the world, whoever follows Me, will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

"The Angels' Candle reminds us that God sent angels to proclaim the coming of Christ to Mary, Joseph, Zacharias, Elizabeth, and the shepherds. The word angel comes from the Greek word angelian, which means messenger.

Luke 2:8-10: "And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear. And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people."

"Today God still uses His angels in accordance with His good will, however, God also wants to use us as messengers as well. The shepherds became messengers of the good news, "glorifying and praising God for all that they had heard and seen..." (2:20) Jesus said: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 28:19). We are not angels, we are in fact men, women, and children created by God for His glory. But He wants us to join with the angels proclaiming the good news. Our Savior is born!"
