Love the Connection!

Our new Sunday schedule has already been a tremendous blessing as almost everyone has stayed for brunch and the Sunday school discussion time following worship. The schedule is working way better than anticipated with some slight adjustments happening as we go. The fellowship and sharing have been infectious. Some are learning and appreciating things about different people that they never knew. It is fun to see people sitting around multiple tables continuing in fellowship even after class is over. It's hard not to love the connection.

I'm excited about the changes we made as well as the willingness of so many to give it a try. It made me think of Romans 12:9-16a – Let love be without hypocrisy. Detest evil; cling to what is good. ¹⁰ Love one another deeply as brothers and sisters. Take the lead in honoring one another. ¹¹ Do not lack diligence in zeal; be fervent in the Spirit; serve the Lord. ¹² Rejoice in hope; be patient in affliction; be persistent in prayer. ¹³ Share with the saints in their needs; pursue hospitality. ¹⁴ Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. ¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice; weep with those who weep. ¹⁶ Live in harmony with one another.

Sunday morning has become an opportunity to see and experience genuine love, honoring one another, fervent spirit, harmony and the sharing of joy and care for one another. It makes me excited to be here. It makes me wonder what God is going to do with this and in us. It spurs me on to strive for the above verses to be true in my life.

Notice verse eleven in the midst of all this love and sharing? Do not lack diligence in zeal; be fervent in the Spirit; serve the Lord. 

Jesus Film Project, a ministry of Cru

Melissa and I have served with the Jesus Film Project (a ministry of Cru) for the past 4 years. The Jesus Film was originally a full length feature film created in 1979. It is a film based completely on the Book of Luke on the life of Christ.

Jesus Film Project's goal is to help people experience Jesus in their own heart language using media, tools and momentum -building strategies. To date, the film can be viewed in over



2000 languages. Over 500 million decisions to follow Jesus have been recorded since its inception.

Today, the Jesus Film Project not only features the Jesus Film, but is comprised of hundreds of short films, resources, digital apps, and strategies to help reach the "Least, Lost and the Last." We partner with over 1,800 ministries and thousands of churches around the globe with one mission in common: to bring the gospel to the entire world through media.

Our role in the Jesus Film is with our Training Strategies team.

While the gospel has never changed, how we communicate the life changing message of the gospel does. We spend the majority of our time equipping our staff, other ministries, and churches in innovative ways to reach lost people with the gospel. Most of these people, some 5 Billion, are found in what is commonly referred to as the 10/40 window. This location is found in eastern hemisphere of the globe.

While born and raised in Pipestone, we have lived in Colorado for the past 6 years with our 4 kids.
