
My Heart if Filled with Thankfulness

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his faithful love endures forever.

² Let the redeemed of the Lord proclaim that he has redeemed them from the power of the foe ³ and has gathered them from the lands—from the east and the west, from the north and the south. ⁴ Some wandered in the desolate wilderness, finding no way to a city where they could live. ⁵ They were hungry and thirsty; their spirits failed within them.

⁶Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble; he rescued them from their distress. ⁷ He led them by the right path to go to a city where they could live. ⁸ Let them give thanks to the Lord for his faithful love and his wondrous works for all humanity. ⁹ For he has satisfied the thirsty and filled the hungry with good things.

¹⁷ Fools suffered affliction because of their rebellious ways and their iniquities. ¹⁸ They loathed all food and came near the gates of death. ¹⁹ Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble; he saved them from their distress. ²⁰ He sent his word and healed them; he rescued them from their traps.

²¹ Let them give thanks to the Lord for his faithful love and his wondrous works for all humanity. ²² Let them offer thanksgiving sacrifices and announce his works with shouts of joy.
